



A. Identify Fixtures

- Use labels found on the box and inside the fixture bodies to identify bodies.
- NOTE: Locations of labels can vary.
- Remove all fixtures from their boxes.
- Organize fixtures based on their labels at the install location.
- Included hardware will vary depending on fixture model and configuration.


- Always use proper safety equipment when installing fixtures.

- Any additional hardware needed for this installation will be provided by others.





RKITB End Socket Bar (QTY: 2)







Step 2 - Disconnect Electrical




A. Disconnect Power



- Shut off power supply to fixture before disconnecting any wiring components.
- Disconnect power feed from fixture according to all local, state and national codes.

B. Remove Bulbs




- Remove the 8 ft bulbs from the sockets.
- Recycle or discard of the bulbs appropriately.


Step 3 - Remove Obsolete Components

B. Remove Bulb Sockets




- Remove the quarter-turn fasteners or screws and uninstall the ballast cover.
- Uninstall the obsolete socket bars and discard.

• Remove the old bulb sockets with associated wiring and discard.

Step 4 - Install Socket Bars



A. Install End/Center Socket Bars



- Install the socket bars to the pan of the fixture with the tabs pointing upwards. Depending on fixture length and configuration a center socket bar may need to be installed as well.
- Ensure that end socket bars are aligned as shown above, with the oblong side closer to the center of the fixture.

B. Install Pre-Wire Sockets




- Install the pre-wired sockets into the socket bars.
- Sockets will click into place when installed properly.
- The following pages show the proper installation of each pre-wired socket configuration. Each configuration corresponds to specific models of the RKITB fixture.








• For the models listed above, the socket with black wires are installed on one end socket bar and the socket with white wires are installed on the opposite end socket bar.

Step 5 - Install Ballast Covers




A. Align Ballast Cover(s)



- Align the holes of the ballast cover(s) to the oblongs of the installed socket bars.
- Ensure tabs of ballast cover(s) are facing the same direction as the tabs of the socket bars.

B. Secure Ballast Cover(s)




Secure Ballast Cover(s)

- Using either the provided self tapping screws or the butterfly nuts, secure the ballast cover(s) to the installed socket brackets.
- Ensure socket wiring is behind ballast cover(s) and that wiring is not damaged while securing ballast cover(s).


Step 6 - Rewire Fixture

- Install the new bulbs (not provided) to the bulb sockets. Slide the bulbs into the slots of the sockets and rotate to secure.
- Wire each fixture to the incoming power supply using the provided quick disconnect clip as shown.
- For dimming option, refer to wiring legend above.
- Use UL approved connectors only. Follow all local, state and national codes. Repeat for all remaining fixtures.
- Install is now complete
